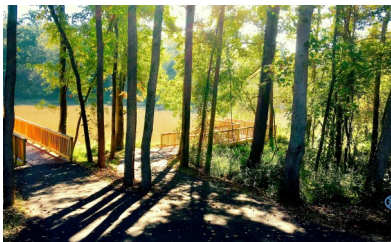
C.B. Huss Recreation Center— Indoor & Outdoor Facility that include a gymnasium, weight room, cardio room, game room, Parks and Recreation Administrative offices, paved walking path, playground, community garden, baseball and soccer fields, picnic shelter, swimming pool, and wading pool.

Community Center & Senior Center— The community center has a full kitchen with refrigerator, microwave, and stove. Tables and chairs are provided for up to 60 adults and the space is available for rent to the general public. The Senior Center is a multi-purpose room consisting of a full kitchen with microwave, stove, refrigerator. The Senior Center can accommodate up to 70 people and is available for rent to the general public.

Goat Island Park & Greenway — Goat Island is a 29 acre park that has two pedestrian bridges over the South Fork river, a 1/4 mile paved walking trail that is part of the Carolina Thread Trail, canoe portage, observation and fishing pier, dog park, outdoor fitness equipment, 2-5 year old playground, 6-12 year old playground, permanent cornhole courts, concrete ping pong tables, and an 18 hole disc golf course.

Riverside Park and Greenway— A linear park that includes an outdoor basketball court, public restrooms, a half mile paved walking trail that is part of the Carolina Thread Trail, kayak portage, observation and fishing pier and picnic shelter.

Central Park— The Towns oldest park with revitalization plans in 2017 that include: improvements to the existing picnic shelter and restrooms, natural surface walking trail, kudzu eradication and designated parking.
