YOUTH SPORTS PARENT ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY

The Cramerton Parks & Recreation Department (CPR) strives to provide positive athletic experiences for all children. We are dedicated to providing every participant an opportunity to learn, play, and have fun. The CPR philosophy is that respect, fairness, participation, and good sportsmanship are more important than winning. In keeping with our philosophy, the following rules and guidelines are provided to ensure that everyone can have and enjoy a positive recreational sports experience.

I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for my child participating in youth sports by following this Code of Conduct and Zero Tolerance Policy:

1. I will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for youth, not adults.
2. I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.
3. I will refrain from "Grandstand" coaching my child or other players during games and practices.
4. I (and, my guests) will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials, and spectators at every game, practice, or other sporting event.
5. My child and I (and, my guests) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, or parent such as booing, harassing and taunting; refusing to shake hands; using profane language or gestures; or any other form of inappropriate behavior.
6. I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
7. I will familiarize myself with the rules of the game and the policies of the league. Rules are available at www.cramerton.org, or you may get a copy from the C.B. Huss Recreation Complex.
8. I will demand that my child treat all other players, coaches, officials, and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, colors, sex, or ability.
9. I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco, and alcohol, and I will refrain from their use at all recreational and leisure facilities.
10. I will emphasize skill development and practices and how they benefit my child over winning. I will deemphasize games and competition in the younger age groups.
11. I will respect the officials and their authority during games and will never question, discuss, or confront officials or coaches at any recreational facility. The official's decision is final. Touching or verbally abusing an official can lead to criminal charges.

If I fail to adhere to these guidelines, I understand that I may be subject to suspension and/or expulsion.

Basketball Skill Assessments & Drafts:

Players 6 and under will be assigned to a team by the Parks & Recreation Department. Basketball players from ages 7-15 will be drafted in order to balance the teams. Players who are not able to come to draft day will be placed into the blind draft. Skill assessments & drafts are usually about an hour. **PARENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE GYM DURING SKILL ASSESSMENT & DRAFT.**

Practice: Practices will begin after November 25th. No practices on November 29 or 30, and December 1, 24, 25, 26, or January 1. Once the season starts, no teams will be allowed to practice at any of the Cramerton Recreation facilities. Games will start after January 2nd and go through mid-late February.

Program Philosophy:

Safe, Fun & Fair. The Cramerton Park Parks and Recreation Department strives to provide a healthy environment in which young people can learn about basketball & cheerleading, develop fundamental skills, coordination, teamwork and most importantly, HAVE FUN. **Parents, remember, it's for the kids!**

Equipment:

- Uniforms: will be provided and distributed by the coach. Player will be given the size that has been ordered on the registration sheet. Shirts must be tucked in during games.
- Shoes: Non-marking gym shoes are mandatory for anyone on the gym floors. Instead of wearing gym shoes into the facility, it is strongly recommended that gym shoes be carried into the facility.
- Jewelry: Not allowed. Taping is not permitted. All jewelry must be removed.
- Players with casts, soft or hard, will not be allowed to play. Casts, padded or not, may cause injury to the player or others.
- **Water only.** No sports drinks or soda allowed.

Cancellations/Delays:

The Parks and Recreation staff is responsible for making the decision on the closing of facilities and game cancellations. The Parks and Recreation website and Facebook page will be updated on an as needed basis throughout the evenings and on weekends. Please respect the decision that is made by the Parks and Recreation Department. The coaches are encouraged to develop a phone tree for easy communication of cancellations and reschedules. Game cancellations will be available by 4pm by calling 704-824-4231 or online at <http://cramerton.org/departments/parks-recreation/>. Cancellations that are not made by 4pm are then the up to the officials discretion.

Team Parent:

Each team should have a team parent help the coach coordinate and organize the snack/drink schedule, team pictures, distribution of flyers, etc. Please volunteer. **All volunteers must be approved through the Cramerton Parks and Recreation Department and are required to wear a badge.**

Facility Rules:

It is important that your team players and parents respect the following facility rules:

- Teams may practice at Cramerton Recreation, Cramerton Middle School, Cramerton Christian Academy, Southminster Church or Stuart Cramer High School. Water is the only beverage allowed in the gyms. Food, gum and all other beverages are not allowed.
- An adult must supervise children at all times. This needs to be stressed to all parents.
- People are not allowed in the hallways or any other area of the building except to use the restrooms.
- Please stay in the gym during practices and games. If children need to use the restroom, concession stand, game room or drinking fountains, an adult must accompany them. They are not allowed to be in the hallways by themselves.
- Siblings of players are welcome. However, an adult, other than a coach, must supervise them if child is under age 8.
- Please leave the facility at your scheduled time. Always remember other teams practice after your practice.
- Smoking is not permitted on recreation grounds. If you need to smoke it must be done in your vehicle.
- Please pick up all trash in the gym, game room and hallways before leaving.
- Basketballs are not allowed in any of the recreation hallways or game room.

Other Important Notes:

- Cramerton Parks and Recreation does not sponsor all-star teams.
- Game schedules will be released mid-December.
- Child birth certificates may be requested.
- Participation trophies will not be provided.
